



The nominated person must be in one of the listed categories and work in the Republic of Ireland. The Veterinary Nurse nominees must be registered with the Veterinary Council of Ireland.

The Practice Hero Award nominations can be submitted for any team member of a PAS accredited Veterinary practice which may include roles such as RVN, Veterinarian, Animal Care Assistant, Receptionist, Practice Manager.

The Student Literature Award must be from a current student enrolled in a Veterinary Nurse Programme which is one of the 5 accredited VN courses in the Republic of Ireland.

The closing date for entries is April 17th. We can accept no responsibility for lost or delayed entries. The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into relating to this Award. The winners of each category will be announced at the social event at the IVNA Annual Congress.

All nominations will be submitted to the IVNA board members anonymously through the PR officer. The board will make a judgement and shortlist the nominations which will then be issued to a panel of judges made from the sponsoring company.

All nominations are judged anonymously, and the winner will only be revealed at the Annual IVNA Congress gala dinner.

Prizes are as follows RVN of the Year cash prize of €750. The nominator for each winner will be notified by post by June following the Event and will receive a One for All gift voucher to the value of €100.

The prize awarded to Practice Hero Award and Student Literature Award is a cash prize of €500 each.

Prize winners' consent to their names and photographs being used in IVNA, Royal Canin, Bayer or Allianz promotional material. Acceptance of the nomination is deemed to be acceptance of the terms and conditions.
